Created between six and five million years ago after an uplifting of the North American tectonic plate, this horseshoe-shaped meander of the Colorado River known as Horseshoe Bend now sits 3,200 feet (980 meters) above sea level. It became a famous and important tourist destination in recent years, mostly thanks to social medias.
